

WHY WE NEED MORE GREENS IN PARLIAMENT



Caroline Lucas MP (pictured above, with **Jack Lenox**) has been the Green Party's only MP since 2010.

Her unwavering commitment and hard work has kept the climate and nature crises on the parliamentary agenda. However, largely due to lobbying from the fossil fuel industry, the Government has made little progress towards net zero carbon emissions.

We need many more **bold and compassionate Green MPs**:

- to lead the way towards low-carbon energy, food and transport systems, as fast as possible
- to tackle the affordable housing and cost of living scandals
- to advocate for peace and international justice, including support for refugees affected by climate change and conflict.
- to invest in the NHS and other public services, and bring railways and utilities such as water back into public ownership.

Only the Greens will bring REAL change

The Conservatives have made themselves unelectable after 14 years of chaos, corruption and austerity.

Polls are consistently showing that the Conservatives will be voted out of Government, and that Labour will win a big majority of seats in 2024.

In our unfair voting system, many people think that, to 'get the Tories out', they have no choice but to vote Labour. That's not true in Lancaster & Wyre.

We need your help to get the message out that the **Tories can't win here**, and one more back-bench Labour MP won't make much difference.

Labour keeps back-tracking on its commitments, abandoning pledges on issues such as green investment and tackling inequality and poverty.

Jack is 36, and joined the Green Party in 2015 because he wanted to help to deliver a hopeful future for our country one where we fund our public services properly, ensure that everyone's basic needs are met, and urgently tackle the climate and nature crises.

He moved from Cumbria to Lancaster in 2019, and was elected to Lancaster City Council in 2021, joining the Green-led Council.

He worked as a software engineer before starting his own business. In 2023 he retrained as a bicycle mechanic and opened Lancaster's first electric bike and cargo bike shop - aiming to promote a shift towards a more sustainable transport system.

Jack is active in our local community. His recent voluntary roles include:

- St John Ambulance vaccinator during the Covid-19 pandemic
- Board member for the Gregson Community Centre
- Member of a Lancashire-based Race Equality Council.

Why voting Green matters

If everyone who votes Green in local elections does so in the next General Election, Jack Lenox would win in Lancaster & Wyre!

Whether or not Jack becomes your next MP, a strong Green vote will help to:

- Make it much easier to win next time. Caroline Lucas won in Brighton after Greens came second there at the previous general election;
- Maximise the Greens' national vote share, giving us more media coverage and more 'short money' (about £1 per vote) for Green MPs.
- Strengthen the case to replace first-past-the-post with a fairer voting system.
- Put pressure on Labour to adopt bolder, greener policies.
